



## ReadyCertify Information:

- ReadyCertify is an emergency management certification program administered by the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management.
- The program is intended to help Cuyahoga County communities and organizations increase their ability to prepare for and respond to large-scale disasters or emergencies.
- The program consists of 24 emergency management performance standards including planning, training, equipping, and public outreach activities.
- **A minimum of 18 of 24** standards must be met to become certified.
  - 12 standards are required
  - 6 of 12 elective standards are required (Applicant's choice)
- Example standards include:
  - The jurisdiction or organization has conducted a Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment of their community
  - The jurisdiction or organization has agreements in place to share resources with other jurisdictions during response and recovery operations
  - The jurisdiction or organization has developed and maintains a plan to disseminate emergency alerts and warnings to the public
- The Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management can provide planning templates and technical assistance to complete the program.
- Communities that complete the program receive a plaque and formal recognition from the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management.
